IAPC Conference Hotel Packages

IAPC has secured a block of hotel rooms for conference attendees at the historic Hotel St. Pierre – a short walking distance from the Cabildo. Rooms are available as a conference registration option on a “first come” basis. Space is limited and early registration is encouraged.

Hotel St. Pierre – IAPC Conference Hotel

On the National Register of Historic Places, the Hotel St. Pierre, with its authentic French Colonial cottages dating back to the 1700's, embodies the architecture, romance, and ambiance of a bygone era. Contributing greatly to the hotel's charm is the relaxed atmosphere of this quiet residential section of the French Quarter. One would never guess its proximity to world class dining, culture, and the lively nightlife of Bourbon Street.

Traditionally decorated rooms and suites include period-style furnishings, plus minifridges, microwaves, flat-screen TVs with cable channels, and free Wi-Fi. Some rooms have 18th-century details, chandeliers and/or balconies. Secluded lush tropical courtyards, balconies, 2 pools, and multiple fountains help make this the perfect spot for an authentic French Quarter event.

Hotel Parking Notice - Now offering offsite self-parking with Premium Parking: \$20 plus tax per night. Both single occupancy (one King Bed) and double occupancy rooms (Two Queen or Twin beds) are available (maximum of four persons per room, including children) with IAPC conference registration.

IAPC World Conference Hotel Packages

IAPC has arranged hotel packages that offer the best available rate and allows IAPC conference attendees to attend the IAPC Conference and remain in New Orleans for the ACA conference, and/or the **French Quarter Festival** which takes place on the weekend immediately following the IAPC Conference.

The IAPC hotel package includes ALL taxes and fees. Cost is “per room” (typical occupancy is one or two people, maximum of four occupants) and conference registrations is required.

Presentation Proposal Submission

IAPC World Conference presenters who wish to share their knowledge and experience are invited to submit a program proposal to the IAPC Conference Program Selection Committee for peer-reviewed selection. Presentation formats include a classroom-style **Presentation** (60 or 90 minute), **Poster Session**, or **Online Presentation** via Zoom at the IAPC Preconference Institute (Saturday, April 6, 2024).

Every effort will be made to accommodate a preferred presentation format. However, given the limited program schedule, Poster Sessions are encouraged. Conference registrants will be notified of their presentation format on a “rolling selection” basis, typically within two weeks of submission – conference registration is required of all presenters. The conference program will be finalized in early January 2024.

Priority consideration will be given to presentation proposals based on original clinical practice-based research, expansion of clinical skills, or professional topics relating to education, training, supervision, ethics, and professional practice.

To submit a presentation for consideration, email the following information to Brian@intapc.org :

- Title of presentation
- Short paragraph summary for inclusion in the conference program
- Name, highest degree, and work title of Primary Presenter
- Curriculum Vitae of the Primary Presenter
- Names, highest degree(s), and work title(s) of co-presenter(s)
- 1 - 2 Page detailed description of presentation (for peer review – do not include presenter names)
- Three goals or learning objectives.
